Pack 310 will once again participate in the BSA's national stewardship program, Scouting for Food. Our scouts are asked to collect *at least 5 bags* of shelf-stable dry goods and health/beauty aids between now and Saturday, October 18th. Den leaders and parents will work cooperatively to deliver the collected items to the Natick Food Pantry on Monday, October 20th.

Remember:

- **Scouts should wear their uniform when asking neighbors/others for support and also when retrieving the filled bags.**
- **You can use the bags provided, or ANY other bag. Let your donors know this as well – exceeding the suggested amount means MORE goods will be provided to our neighbors in need.**
- **The Natick Food Pantry is a volunteer-run organization, overseen by the Natick Service Council. A list of suggested and requested items is available on the Natick Service Council website, natickservicecouncil.org.**
- **Items of PARTICULAR NEED this season: Canned Tuna, Meals in a Box (i.e. Hamburger Helper, etc.), Instant Mashed Potatoes, Rice Pilaf or other Dried Rices, Shampoo, Toothpaste, Toothbrushes, Body Soap/Body Wash.**
- **Collect filled bags by Saturday, October 18th.**
- **Every Den that collects at least 5 bags per scout will earn a ribbon for their Den Staff!**
